Mistley Kids Club



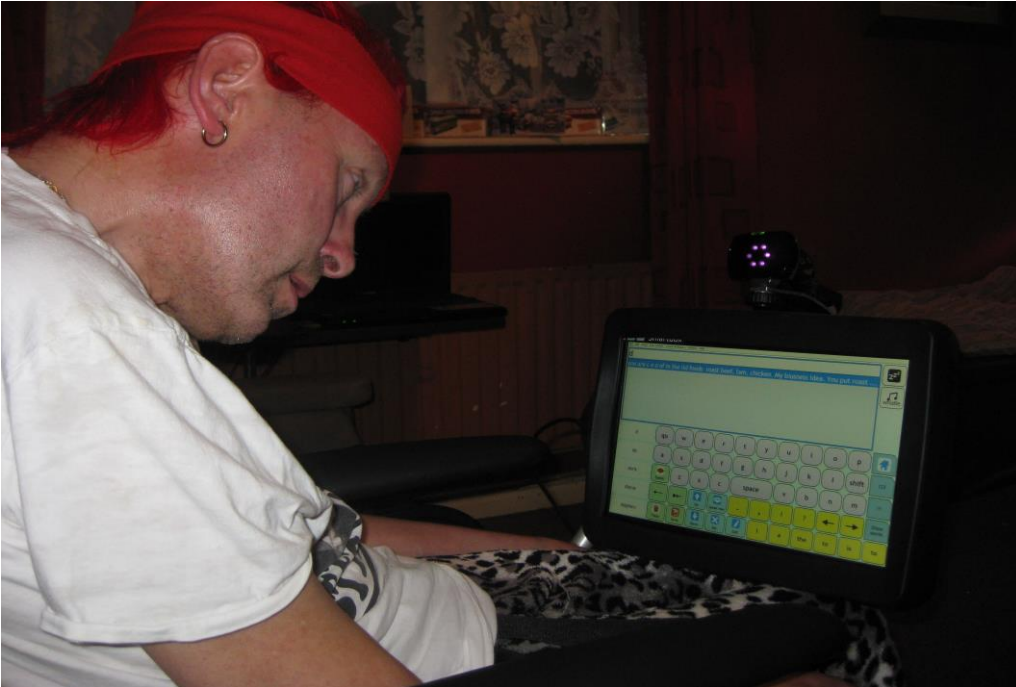
Children from Mistley Kids Club enjoying an outing during the summer holiday programme
